FLOOD RELIEF PROGRAM

~4,496 people received food materials, toiletries and other necessary items under flood relief program across 20 villages of Uttar Pradesh and Jharkhand



FINANCIAL & DIGITAL LITERACY PROGRAM

~3,211 women were educated on financial management through literacy program organized across Puducherry, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh. Simultaneously, ~2,269 rural communities were benefitted by multiple govt. schemes such as e-shram, ayushman bharat, income certificate, kisan samman nidhi through 'Fusion Sahayata Kendra'.



HEALTH CAMPS

WATERWHEEL DISTRIBUTION

Waterwheels distributed to 135 women in 15 villages of Bihar and Madhya Pradesh. Beneficiaries can conveniently fetch up to 45L of water in a hygienic manner eliminating the burden of commuting long distances to carry heavy containers of water.
